This means that you may not seek any kind of exam aid by using any online search engine, and you may not use any graphing or computational aids such as Matlab, Mathematica, etc.

# Quizzes and Exams

- ▶ Our two remaining quizzes and remaining midterm will be administered through Canvas. They are no longer affiliated with studio.
- ▶ Each quiz and exam will open for a 24-hour period, from Friday 8 AM (Atlanta time) to Saturday 8 AM (Atlanta time).
- ▶ Once you open a quiz, you will have a 15-minute time limit to complete it. The midterm will have a 75-minute time limit once it is opened.
- ▶ Students with extended time accommodations will receive still receive extended time on the quizzes and exams.

# Grade Breakdown

At the end of the semester, your instructor will compute your overall numerical score for the course using the *higher* of the two following grading schemes.

1. The grade breakdown described on page 3 of the [common syllabus](#). This includes the partial grade replacement policy for students who fare better on the final exam than on their worst midterm (as described in the syllabus).
2. The following grade breakdown:
  - ▶ 10% class participation (3 drops)
  - ▶ 10% homework (2 drops)
  - ▶ 20% quizzes (1 drop)
  - ▶ 15% for midterm 1
  - ▶ 15% for midterm 2
  - ▶ 15% for midterm 3
  - ▶ 15% for the final exam

## Lectures, Studio, Office Hours, PLUS sessions

- ▶ Lectures, studio, and office hours will all be held through BlueJeans for the remainder of the semester.
- ▶ Lectures and studios will be recorded, so if you are unable to log in to lecture live for any reason, you can view it later.
